Academic Learning

Routine is still a very important learning focus for Junior Kindy students. This focus will continue throughout the year to help your child feel secure and confident at Kindy.

On Monday and Tuesday, all Kindergarten children will continue to explore colours, shapes, patterns, sequencing and matching. This content is covered in a whole class setting, in small groups and in one-on-one situations to allow the teachers to better meet the needs of each child.

Junior Kindy students will have some exposure to the alphabet and letter sounds this term, and as the year progresses. However, it is in an informal manner until next year when your child starts Senior Kindy. This will mainly be during singing, puzzles and student prompted observations during recess and activity-time.

Junior Kindy students will be present for some fun with Science and Technology this term. We will be designing, building, testing and comparing various constructions.

Routines

Library is starting for the Junior Kindy children this term. We visit the library each Tuesday and your child will get to choose a book to borrow and take home for 1 week. Children will need to return their library book each Monday in preparation for the following lesson.

Throughout the term, we will have our theme days. This term we will focus on patterns and stripes rather than colours. I will inform you when these special occasions occur so that your child can bring in an item from home. Please remember it can be something very simple including a piece of clothing, a plate, a book or a toy.
